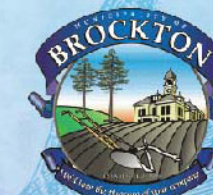
The Fish Art Story

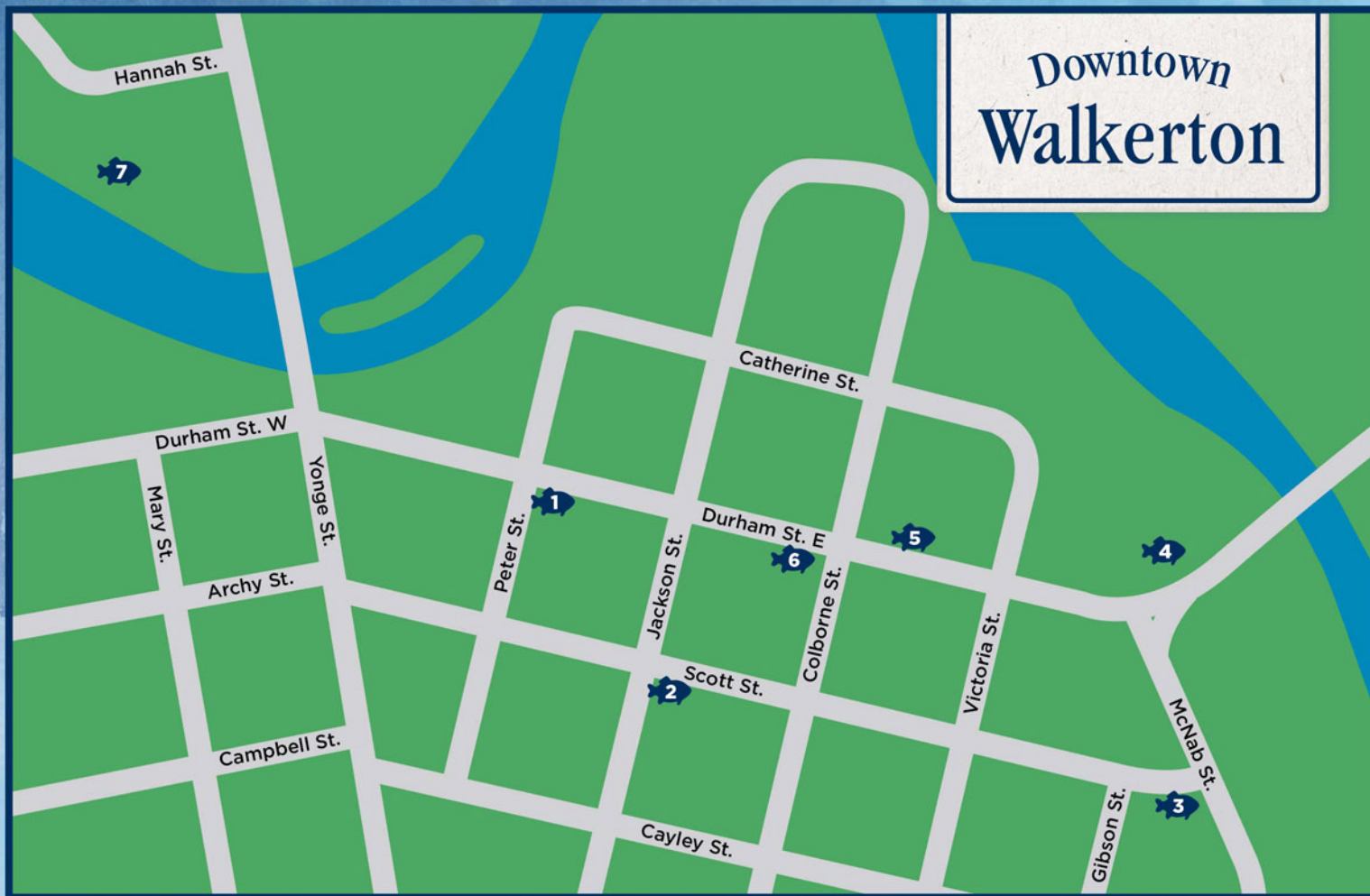

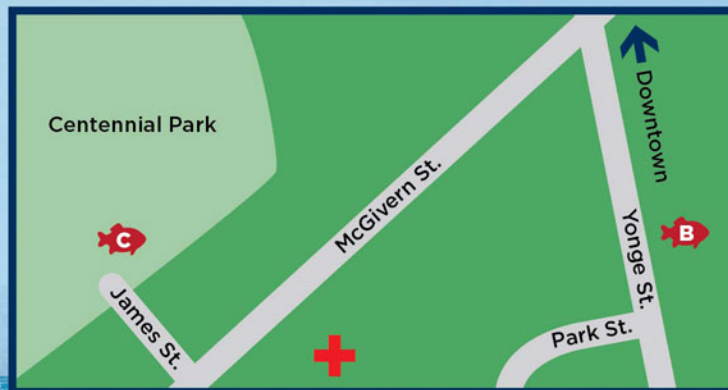
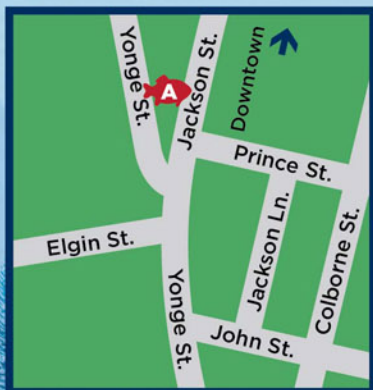
