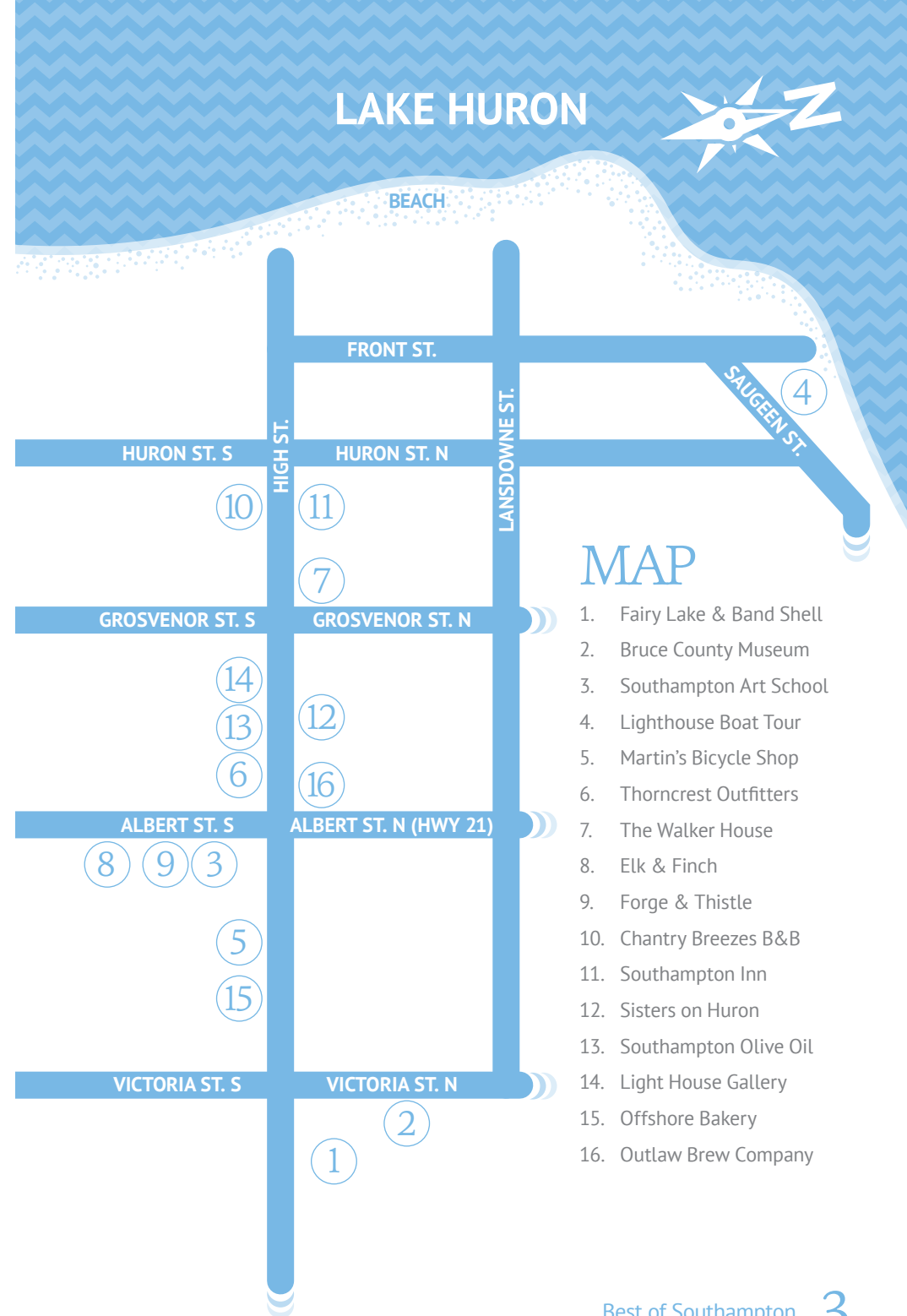

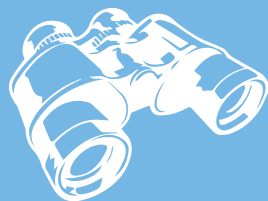
The places featured in this booklet are within strolling distance of each other. As you stroll around Southampton, strangers might smile or even say hello.

– Fairy Lake & Band Shell –

Fairy lake is a magical place that is home to swans, ducks, fish, turtles and other wildlife. A fountain splashes in the centre of the lake while a nature trail wraps around the perimeter. This is the perfect place to take a relaxing stroll or observe the wildlife. Each Sunday night, during the summer, Fairy Lake becomes the backdrop for live music. Bring your lawn chairs and enjoy the evening show.

— Lighthouse Boat Tour —

The Imperial Lighthouse on Chantry Island, a mile offshore, is a must see for lovers of lighthouses and birders alike. The 2 hour excursion from Southampton Harbour offers a guided tour of the restored Keeper's Cottage, and a chance to climb the 106 stairs to the top, from which you can see the interesting birdlife that inhabits this federal Bird Sanctuary. From the top of the tower, and during your boat trip over, you can see some of the shipwrecks that dot our waters.

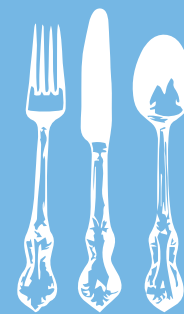


Take a Paddle

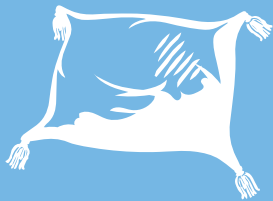
